Physician and Lawyer, 51, Was Member of A. F. & A. M. and Zulueta.

Dr. H. H. Meleck, 51, Minneapolis physician and lawyer, died Tuesday morning at his home, 1111 Grove avenue north, from a heart attack, after two days of illness. He had lived here 40 years.
